

## October Scor-Pal project

### Candle lamp or lampshade

You will need scrapbooking paper, wineglasses, tea lights (or use LED versions), embellishments, ribbon, Scor-Pal.

1. Cut out two identical pieces of solid cardstock. If you find cardstock with needed length you may use one piece of cardstock. The longer the strip the more puffy lampshade you will get.

I took such measurements:

height -14 cm

length-30 cm



2. I covered the inside of the lampshade with foil. Foil acts as reflector, makes the construction more sturdy and flexible, protects from heat.



3. Using Scor-Pal Scoring Board I made score lines on both pieces of cardstock. Width between two score lines is 2.5 cm.

You get very neat score lines when you use Scor-Pal.



4. I cut out strips from Steampunk Spells 6x6 Patterns & Solids Pad and glued them on both parts of the lampshade. Don't forget to leave the space for attaching two pieces together.



5. I attached two pieces into continuous "circle".



6. I made holes in the top side of the lampshade. By pulling ribbon in the holes I shaped my lampshade as desired.



7. It is convenient to keep lampshade until the next event.



8. You can use the LED lights.
